Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: Who will be responsible for the participants throughout the 3 days?

A: Our color guard instructional staff will ensure the safety of camp participants and address their needs. Pacific Crest administrators and staff will also be on hand.

Q: What do I need to bring?

A: For the three-day camp, you will need to have appropriate attire for three active days of color guard rehearsal/activities. You will also need to bring a flag. And bring a rifle and saber if you have access to them.

Suggested Packing List (Commuter Camp)

Clothes/shoes for color guard rehearsals/activities
Bring all equipment you want to improve on, e.g. flag, rifle, saber
Baseball hat, lip balm, sunscreen, sunglasses
Water jug (half-gallon) or reusable water bottle
Jacket/sweatshirt and long pants/sweats for cold weather
Small backpack for any supplies/personal items needed if desired
Pen and pencil

Q: Will there be a First-Aid Kit available?

A: Yes. A first-aid kit is always available at Pacific Crest's mobile kitchen. We also will have health team members on site.

Q: Will there be a place to store personal items (cell phone, wallet, keys, etc.)?

A: The camp will require moving around to other places. It is advised you leave valuables/personal items at home. If you do decide to bring anything with you, be sure to keep it with you at all times. Pacific Crest is not responsible for loss/damage of personal property.

Q: Do I need to bring money?

A: Everything is covered under your registration fee, so there is no need to bring additional money with you to the camp.
